Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

Nominations are called for: District High School Sector

Branch Councillor (1) for the remainder of the term

Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Branch, may be made at any time from 22/11/2018.

Nomination forms are available on request.

All candidates must be nominated in writing by two financial members from the same sector as the sector for which the candidate is nominating. The nomination shall be signed by the nominee and the nominators.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the Branch's rules prior to lodging nominations.

Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement methods stipulated below **not later than** 5:00pm Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on 13/12/2018.

How to lodge nominations, nominations must be lodged via the following methods:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 5:00pm AWST on 13/12/2018.

Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 28/01/2019 and close at 5:00pm AWST on 19/02/2019.

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers on open on 28/01/2019 and close at 5:00pm AWST on 19/02/2019.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
