

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PFWA RULE CHANGE

To all members of the Principals Federation of Western Australia as addressed:

This is to advise that at the Ordinary Meeting of the PFWA Council on Friday 2 August 2019, the Council resolved to change the Rules of the PFWA.

The attached draft of the new Rules contains marked up edits to the following rules:

Rule 2 – change of address.

Rule 7 – acknowledges the existence of the education support sector within the rules and makes provision for education support members to be allocated to the education support sector.

Rule 18 – alters the constitution of the Council to include up to 4 positions representing education support members.

Rule 20 – alters the constitution of the Executive to include a member of the education support sector as members of the Executive.

The reason for these changes is to make provision for the education support members of the Federation to have equal representation on the Council and the Executive in the same way as members of the other three sectors now enjoy. In addition, the new office address is to be incorporated into the Rules.

The Council intends to make an application to the Registrar of the Western Australian Industrial Relations Commission to register the new changes as resolved by the Council.

Each member of the Federation has the right to object to the application to register the new Rules. Members can write a letter or via email registry@wairc.wa.gov.au to the Registrar at Level 17, 111 St Georges Terrace Perth WA 6000. A stamped copy of your objection must be served on the Federation no later than 7 days prior to the hearing of the application. The objection must clearly state the grounds of the objection and must specify with particularity the manner in which the objector is or is likely to be affected by the application. At the hearing of the application, the objector may only be heard on the grounds of the objection unless leave is granted by the Commission.
