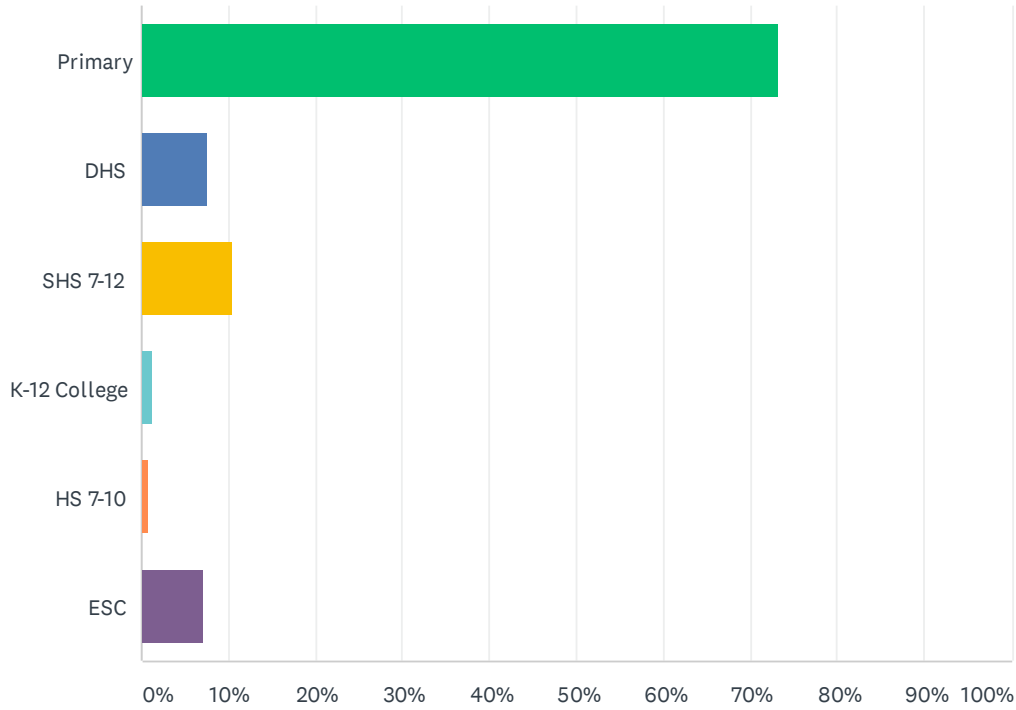

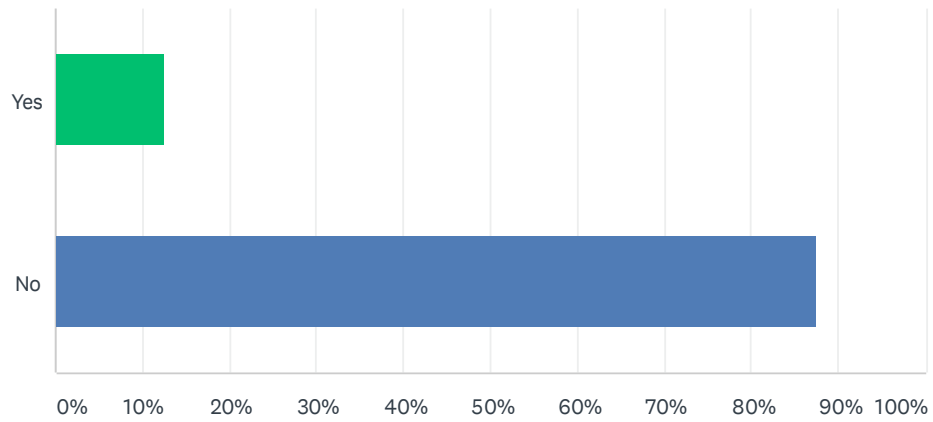

Q6 Have any administration and school leadership team accessed sick leave to commence Term 2?

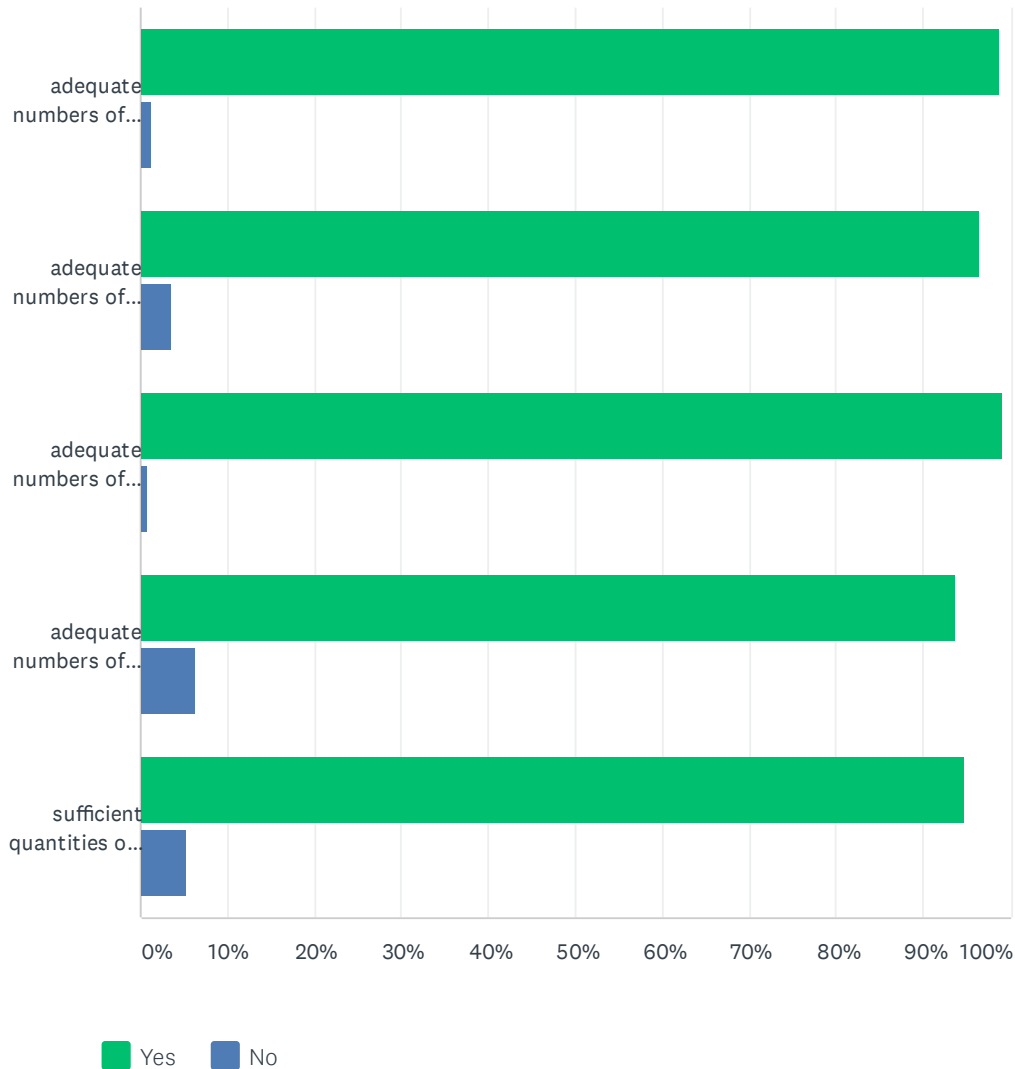

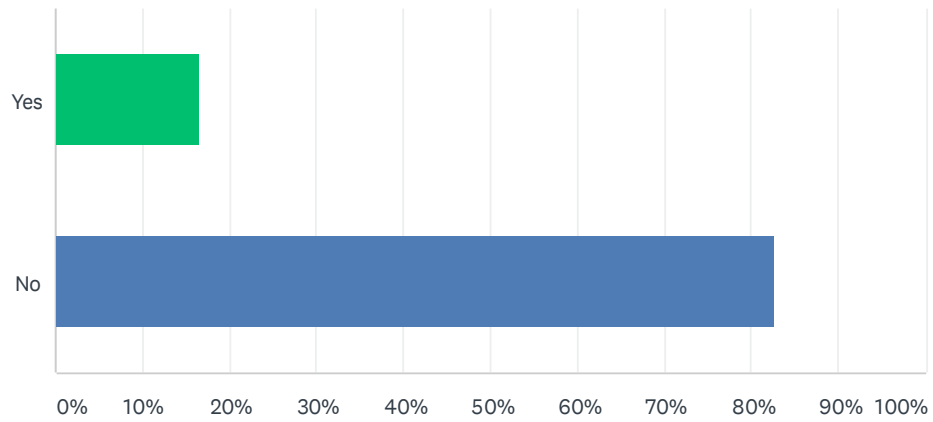
